IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING THE CONSTRUCTION INDUCTION CARD COURSE

This course was introduced by WorkSafe Victoria in July 2008 to REPLACE the course known as "The Red Card"

A "Confirmation of Booking", such as this document, can be used by the holder to gain access to a construction site until the Expiry Date, which is detailed on the first page of this document.

Once a booking has been made and payment has been taken for this course there are no refunds or re-bookings.

Applicants that hold a red card should know that Red Cards are still accepted in Victoria and do not technically have an expiry date.

The Construction induction card is a National Unit of Competency

Training organisations are bound by WorkSafe Victoria's guidelines in order to be able to deliver the course. Some of these guidelines include:

Applicants cannot enrol for this course more than 28 days in advance.

Applicants must provide proof of identity at enrolment. The identification that can be accepted is as follows:

- Passport (Australian Passport current or expired WITHIN the last two years, but not cancelled. International Passports MUST be current)
- Drivers Licence – Australian with photo. MUST be current
- Drivers Licence Permit – Australian with photo. MUST be current.
- Boat Operators Licence – Australian with photo. MUST be current.
- Firearm Licence – Victorian with photo, must be current. Interstate licence can be accepted as long as it contains a photo and is current.
- Licence to Perform High Risk Work - that is current and not expired.
- State/Territory or Federal Government Employee Card – with photo
- Other Australian Government issued ID card – with photo.
- Keypass ID card – with photo.
- Consumer Affairs Victoria Proof of Age Card – with photo

We are unable to allow entry into the course without the said Identification. Applicants that arrive without the required ID will be refused entry into the class, and be required to make an additional booking into another class on another date AT THEIR OWN COST. Cove Training will not bear the cost of an additional booking due to inadequate identification reasons.

Once the applicant has successfully completed the course, they will be issued with a Statement of Attainment that is valid for 60 days from the date of the course.

The applicant can obtain access onto a construction site with the Statement of Attainment until WorkSafe Victoria issued them with their White Card, which will be sent by post within 60 days from the date course.

WorkSafe Victoria is responsible for the printing and postage of the card once the course can be completed. Issues relating to the receipt of the card can be directed directly to WorkSafe Victoria.
