

FORK LIFT LICENCE -FOR BEGINNERS-

LICENCE TO PERFORM HIGH RISK WORK (WORKSAFE VICTORIA) APPROVED LICENCE

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course is designed for people who have no prior experience driving a forklift and wish to obtain their WorkSafe Victoria Licence to Perform High Risk Work.

In order to obtain your licence, applicants must be deemed competent by a WorkSafe Victoria Accredited Assessor. To do this applicants must pass a theory (written) assessment as well as a drive assessment.

Our aim is to teach novice operators how to safely and competently operate a forklift in a casual and laid back training environment, over the two days—usually enough time to achieve competency, but not enough time to get bored!

We provide a range of different types of forklifts, so you are welcome to sit your assessment on any one you choose during the course.

TOPICS INCLUDE

- Theoretical training session prior to your written assessment
- Legislation covering the operation of a forklift
- Driving practice prior to your drive assessment
- Safe operation of a forklift
- Pre-operation and Post-operation checks
- Practical obstacle course
- Advanced obstacle operation

OUTCOME OF COURSE:

- We provide several different types of forklifts, so you can select the one you wish to do your drive assessment on.
- Ready to be employed
- Compliant to the national standards
- Oral/Verbal testing available if requested
- Trained by WorkSafe accredited assessor

PRE REQUISITES

Students have a sound grasp on the English language, including written and oral communication skills.

Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.

Applicants must provide WorkSafe Victoria approved identification (ie: valid drivers licence is acceptable). Please contact our office for a list of valid identification if you do not have a current valid drivers licence.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

This is a Licence to Perform High Risk Work issued by WorkSafe Victoria. Once the applicant has been deemed competent, the applicant must apply for the licence at an approved Australia Post Office. Applicant must also provide 100 points of ID at the Post Office for the processing.

COURSE COSTS

\$350.00 to undertake the course, and then \$60.00 to WorkSafe Victoria for the issue of the licence card.

COURSE DURATION

2 X 8 hour sessions. Usually runs Mondays to Fridays.
